



Masters Athletics Competition “AŽUOLO TAURĖ“ 2024 REGULATIONS

1. OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. To promote and develop track and field athletics among masters in Klaipėda County, Lithuania and other countries.
- 1.2. Identify the best masters.
- 1.3. Following the example of Latvia, to organize competitions between Klaipėda County municipalities' masters and their families.
- 1.4. To promote cooperation between municipal masters, national associations, and to foster friendship.

2. DATE AND PLACE

- 2.1. The competition will take place on September 07-08, 2024 at Klaipėda City Central Stadium (address: Sportininkų Str. 46, Klaipėda).
- 2.2. Start of the competition:
SEPTEMBER 07, 13:00
SEPTEMBER 08, 10:00

3. ORGANIZERS

4. PARTICIPANTS

- 4.1. Masters born no later than on September 7, 1994 are invited to participate in the competition (setting the participants' age limit is based on the participant's date of birth: the age of a participant on September 07, 2024). Husbands or wives of participants and their children/grandchildren of up to 3 to 17 years of age are also invited to participate. Children between the ages of 3 and 7 participate only in the 30m race.

Children from 8 to 14 years of age participate in 100m, 200m, long jump events. Children from 15 to 17 years of age participate in events of 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, high jump, long jump, long jump from place.

Children only participate if their parents or grandparents participate in any event.

4.2. When registering, each participant confirms that:

4.2.1. He or she has sufficient physical fitness, is in good health, and therefore is ready to compete in the events for which the participant has registered;

4.2.2. He or she agrees with the Regulations and verbal instructions that have been or will be set by the organizers of the competition;

4.2.3. The information he or she provided during registration is correct;

4.2.4. The participant does not object to the use of his or her personal data in the competition protocols, and to the right of the competition organizers to use his or her image in photos and videos in the competition-related publicly available information.

5. PROGRAMME

5.1. Women/Men: **1.30m** (for children of 3 to 7 years of age); **2.100m**; **3.200m**; **4.400m**; **5.800m**; **6.1500m**; **7.3.000m**; **8.3.000m** walk; **9.Hurdles** 80m,100m,110m; **10.High Jump**; **11. Long Jump**; **12.Triple Jump**; **13.Jump For Place**; **14.Shot Put**; **15.Javelin Throw**; **16.Discus Throw**; **17.Hammer Throw**; **18.Weight Throw**;

5.2. The preliminary competition schedule is attached to these regulations, the final one will be published on September 4, 2024.

6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTING PARTICIPANTS AND REGISTRATION

6.1. Start of registration: July 22, 2024 at:

6.2. End of registration: 8 p.m. on September 2, 2024.

6.3. Expenses related to participation in the championship are covered by the participant himself/herself or the managing organization.

6.4. Participation fee: Entry fee 10 EUR plus 3 EUR for each event. The fee does not apply to children and grandchildren. The participation fee should be paid until 4 September 2024.

6.6. Participation fee can be paid in cash in the Stadium. Payment cards are not accepted. If a participant does not start in a competition or in some of the disciplines, the participation fee will not be refunded.

6.7 Registration of participants on the day of the competition is possible only if registration is made 2 hours before the competition. The participant pays an additional 15 EUR in cash.

7. Technical Rules

7.1. The competition is held according to the rules of the World Masters Association (WMA).

7.2. An official appointed during the competition has the right to disqualify a participant in the competition whose participation would pose a threat to his or her health or that of other participants.

7.3. The organizers are not responsible for any damage to the participant's health, loss of the participant's property or other damage that the participant may suffer during the competition or due to circumstances related to the competition.

8. Winners and Awards

8.1. WMA Annual Age Coefficients determine winners.

8.2. Each participant is given a certificate with the achieved results and a souvenir.

8.3. "Ąžuolas" cups are awarded to the woman and man who achieved the best results according to the new IAAF point table.

8.4. Prizes of 100 Eur are awarded to the best masters among all age groups who have achieved the highest results according to the IAAF scoring table:

1. In jumping events for man and woman.
2. In running and walking events for man and woman.
3. In throwing events for man and woman.
